

Hong Kong Leads the Way in Tourism Growth, Attracting Affluent Travelers from Across the Globe Amid Rising Geopolitical Uncertainties

Hong Kong, as the world faces rising geopolitical uncertainties, Hong Kong has emerged as a standout destination for affluent FIT (Free Independent Travelers) seeking to maintain their [travel](#) plans and spending despite global inflation. According to a recent survey conducted during the ITE Hong Kong 2026, a premier travel trade event set to take place from June 11 to 14, 2026, the city is witnessing increased tourism spending, even as other markets struggle with economic challenges.

A Surge in Tourism Demand in Hong Kong

In 2024, Hong Kong was the 14th largest outbound travel market globally by spending, reaching US\$28.9 billion. This impressive figure comes as no surprise, as the city has been a hub for business travelers, leisure tourists, and high-end visitors alike. In fact, resident departures from Hong Kong totaled 117 million in 2025, a 12.3% increase compared to the previous year. This growth is expected to continue, with a remarkable 3 million people leaving Hong Kong during the 2026 Spring Festival, marking a 22% increase in outbound travel.

Affluent FIT Travelers: A Resilient Market

The ITE 2026 survey revealed some key insights into how travelers are reacting to the uncertainties surrounding global politics. A significant portion of the respondents, who were frequent and affluent travelers, indicated that they were not reducing their travel budgets despite geopolitical instability. In fact, 62.5% of the survey participants plan to increase their travel budgets, with only 12.2% opting to reduce their spending.

Among those surveyed, 74.6% of travelers took multiple outbound holidays in 2025, and over half of them held university degrees. These insights demonstrate a clear trend: affluent travelers continue to prioritize their leisure and business travels, even in the face of economic and political challenges. Their increased spending on travel further supports the notion that Hong Kong remains an attractive destination for high-end tourists.

The Impact of the Greater Bay Area (GBA) on Tourism Growth

One of the most notable developments for Hong Kong's tourism market is its deepening connection with the Greater Bay Area (GBA). In 2024, the GBA's combined GDP reached an impressive US\$2.09 trillion, underscoring its importance as a driver of economic activity in the region. The ITE survey found that 70% of trade buyers at the event hailed from the GBA, including delegates from major cities such as Guangzhou, Shenzhen, and Hong Kong itself. The region's rapidly growing population, which exceeds 87 million, provides a large and increasingly affluent customer base for tourism-related businesses in Hong Kong.

With the GBA serving as a critical economic engine for Hong Kong, tourism-related sectors such as hospitality, retail, and transportation are benefiting from this dynamic market. Tourists from the GBA are flocking to Hong Kong for leisure, business, and shopping, further reinforcing the city's status as a global tourism hub.

Hong Kong's Rising Appeal to FIT Travelers

Hong Kong continues to shine as a destination of choice for FIT travelers who prefer to explore the city at their own pace. These travelers typically opt for private tours or bespoke travel experiences, making them a significant source of revenue for the city's tourism industry. The 2025 ITE survey revealed that 80% of public visitors to the event preferred traveling as FITs or on private tours. This segment of the market is poised for further growth, as travelers seek personalized and high-quality experiences in Hong Kong.


With its extensive range of luxury hotels, fine dining establishments, world-class shopping malls, and iconic attractions, Hong Kong offers a unique blend of modernity and tradition. Visitors can experience the city's rich cultural heritage, bustling street markets, stunning skyline, and serene parks, making it an ideal destination for affluent travelers seeking both adventure and relaxation.

Increased Spending and Strategic Planning for Future Growth

Despite global inflation and the impact of geopolitical uncertainties, Hong Kong's tourism industry has managed to remain resilient. The organizers of ITE Hong Kong, TKS Exhibition Services Ltd, have strategically focused on maintaining affordable space rental rates to ensure the event's continued success. While the event's space rental fees were increased by just 2.19% in 2026, the organizers have kept costs stable since 2019, ensuring accessibility for exhibitors and trade buyers.

ITE Hong Kong 2026 will focus on promoting innovative business matching services, where exhibitors and buyers can engage in quick meetings to maximize their business potential. Additionally, the event will feature trade seminars, KOL (Key Opinion Leader) networking opportunities, and public seminars to attract both B2B and B2C visitors. The event's robust platform is expected to drive tourism growth in Hong Kong by fostering connections between suppliers, buyers, and travelers.
