

ITE Hong Kong 2021 will be held in July-August instead of June

Trade Days: Jul 29 – 30 | Public Days: Jul 31 – Aug 1 Halls 1A, B & C; Hong Kong Convention & Exhibition Centre (HKCEC)

Recent developments, which include downward trend of new cases, vaccinations, Travel Pass App and Travel Health Certificate, extensive testing and more effective lock down, growing economic pressure to re-open border, and pent-up demand etc., are strong force pushing for border re-opening and tourism recovery, thus improve chance of successfully holding this year ITE Hong Kong, the city's only travel fair!

However, uncertainty still exist! For more preparation time and a wider safety margin, after consultations, TKS the organizer reschedule date of **ITE 2021 from June to July 29-August 1**.

Health and safety our prime concern, and our measures at fairground include for examples QR Code / form for tracing, wider aisles, wearing mask and crowd control etc. all of which in accordance with the latest guidelines from the government. Our contingency plan also include activating online platform before, during and after show period.

Held annually since the Eighties, ITE has separate days, admission policy and program for over 11,000 regional trade and some 75000 FIT/public. Specifically, some 60% of ITE's buyers and trade visitors from locally, 20% from the Greater Bay Area, 10% each from other parts of China and Asia.
